5. To provide healthcare and health services to the students by establishment of Allopathic, Ayurvedic, homoeopathic, Naturopathic, Yoga therapy centres at various places in India and abroad.
6. To develop programmes and projects in villages to provide eye camps for eye treatment and general treatments for poor people in rural and village areas.
7. To work for the poorer persons of the society to help them in all fields, in all possible manners, to provide them food, clothes, shelters-homes, lower to higher level education, self-employment, training centres and to help them in all respects.
8. 12. To arrange establish and or run primary, middle and/or higher secondary senior secondary school/ coaching classes and degree colleges, educational/technical/medical/vocational schools/computer institutions and to provide the general & professional education to the students of all sections, and also to bring the education of bet standard within the reach of poor and backward children at the lowest possible cost.
13. To the objects for which trust fund is established are social welfare/charitable upliftment, and development of needy, destitute and down trodden children and advancement of any other charitable objects of general public utility, not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit and for such purposes.

To help poor children, poor people destitute work for family welfare programmes, Rural upliftment and development in accordance with Gramswaraj and Panchayati Raj, and to work for the protection of human rights.To struggle for justice on social issues. To educate and create awareness among general public, about various developmental programmes of Central and state government, and to extend all possible help and cooperation for their effective participation.
15. To launch and promote the health awareness programmes like immunizations, family plannings, HIV/AIDS, leprosy, tuberculosis, cancer, drug de-addiction for all age groups through cultural programme.

3. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TRUST:


The administration of the TRUST shall vest with the board of trustees, which consist of:-

- a. One managing trustee;
- b. One joint managing trustee;
- c. One deputy Managing Trustee and three trustees;

4. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Board of trustee shall have the control and management of the trust and exercise the following powers:

- a. To determine from time to time to commence and to take up the object and purposes for which the funds of the trust shall be used and allot and allocate to each of the objects such portion of the funds as they deem fit.
- b. To purchase and acquire any immovable property of any kind for this object of the trust, or as a source of income for the trust.
- c. To sell mortgage or dispose of any immovable property/properties belonging to the trust.
- d. To inquire all expenditure necessaryas in their own opinionuseful for carrying out the objects and administration of the trust.
- e. To sell, lease, mortgage or dispose of any property immovable property/properties belonging to the trust.
- f. To open one or more bank accounts of the trust with any bank or banks as the trustees may deem fit and deposit money of the trust in the bank accounts.
- g. To borrow for and on behalf of the trust, with or without security from banks, governments, universities or any other government body/bodies, both central and state.
- h. Two employee staff of all kinds necessary and useful for carrying out the objects of the trust.
- i. To incur such other items of expenditure as is necessary and incidental for carrying out the objects of the trust.
- j. To institute conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, refer to arbitration, or to do such things as are incidental and necessary. Concerning the efforts of the trust and to sign and verify vakalats,pleandings, affidavits and other powers.



- k. To delegate all or any of the powers vested in the trustees to any body to frame rules, bylaws and other courts for the conduct of the affairs of trust and its transaction and establishing any communities.
- l. Addition To accept contributions in cash or in kind either by way of to the trust funds generally or for anyone or more of specified objects of the trust.
- m. To establish as many ad hoc committees for any purpose.
- n. To frame bylaws and rules and regulations for the conduct of the business of the trust and its officers and employees.


5. MEETINGS OF THE TRUSTEES:

- a. The Managing Trustee/settler shall preside over all the meetings of the trustees and in his absence the joint managing trustee shall preside such meeting and in the absence of both the trustees attended such meetings may elect anyone of them to preside over the meeting.
- b. The meetings of the trustees may be convened by the Managing Trustee or under his direction, by any other trustee.
- c. The quorum of the meeting of the trustee shall be four personally present.
- d. In the event of equality of votes, the person residing such meeting shall excise casting vote(additional vote).

6. RESOLUTIONS:

- a. The trustees may exercise all the powers vested in them in clause under 9 these presents by resolution passed at simple majority of the trustees attended such meetings of the board of trustees.
- b. Any resolution in writing signed by all trustees holding office for the time being shall be valid and binding.

7. **SUITS:** The Managing Trustee of the trust is authorised to sue or to be sued on behalf of the trust.



8. EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS:

All deeds, documents, etc, shall be executed by the Managing Trustee, Joint Managing Trustee and deputy managing trustee, jointly representing the trust.

9. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

a. That the regular accounts will be maintained relating to all receipt, payments, income and all liabilities of the trust, all the gift and contribution received from any persons will be added in the panel of donation paid panel. And the account will be audited for their interest of trust.

b. The trustee shall maintain true and correct accounts of all trust monies and all the income and investment and all the outgoing expenses.

c. The year of accounts shall be the financial year commencing from 1st April and ending 31st March.

d. The trustees shall each year issue a report setting out the accounts showing the income and expenditure of the trust for the preceding year, not later than the six months from the end of preceding year of accounts.

e. The accounts of the trust shall be audited every year by a chartered accountant who may be appointed for the purpose by the board of trustees and the audited statement of accounts together with auditors report shall be laid before the board of trustees for approval.

10. BANK ACCOUNT:

The founders/settlers along with the trustees shall operate bank accounts jointly. To open account in the name of trust and/or institutions run conducted by the trust with nationalised bank or scheduled bank or private banks, either by way of fixed deposit or in saving account to be operated by founders/trustees and the other trustee shall be nominated by the trustees, for the purpose from the time to time, or open bank accounts with any nationalised bank/other bank, and give directions to transfer, endorse, and sign. Government securities or security instruments.

11. **POWER TO ALTER RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

The Board of Trustees shall have Full power and authority to make, alter and rescinded rules and regulations for the management and administration of the trust. Any amendment to the trust deed will be carried out only with the approval of the commissioner of income tax.

12. **APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND:**

The board of trustees shall be empowered to invest the funds of the trust in movable or immovable properties in such manner as they deem fit for the purpose of the objects of the trust, provided that such investment shall be accordance with the provision of section 13(I) readwith section 11(5) of income tax act 1961. As well as of any other law for the time being in force, as are applicable to charitable trust.

13. **REMUNERATION TO THE TRUSTEES:**


The trustees are not entitled for any remuneration, but they shall however be entitled to receive out of pocket expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the functions of the trust. Further, the income and funds of the trust will be solely utilised towards the objects, and no portion of it will be utilised for payment of trustees by way profits, interest and dividend or otherwise.

14. **INDEMNITY:**

Every trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund in respect of any loss arising from our contingent upon any investment made out of monies of trust, unless such loss shall have been occasioned by own negligence. And also, every trustee shall be indemnified out of the trust against all proceedings, suits, claims, cost, damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the matters or affairs relating to the trust created by these presents or in the exercise of power or discretion vested in them by virtue of this presents.

15. **IRREVOCABILITY:**

The trust shall be an irrevocable public educational, charitable, cultural trust for the benefit of all persons belonging to whatever community irrespective of caste, creed or religion, the trustee shall stand possessed of the said amount of corpus endowed by the authors of the trust and such other properties(Both movable and immovable) As may acquired from time to time by the trust, by purchase, exchange, grant allotment, subscription, endowment, donation, contribution, or in any manner to whatsoever (All of which shall be designed as trust properties) On the trust, herein mentioned.



ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST:

16. The activities of the trust shall be only within India and its union territories, and shall not be extended anywhere outside India.

DISSOLUTIONS:

17. On dissolution of the trust, the net profit and net assets of the trust shall be transferred to an association of persons or trust or society having similar objects of this trust.

PROCEEDING OF THE TRUST:



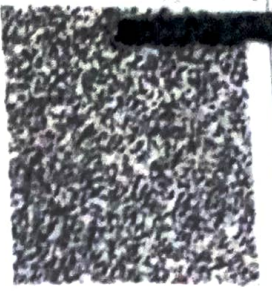
